

Check before you invest

Generally, anyone selling securities, offering investment advice or acting as a fund manager in Canada **must register** with a securities regulator.

Three checks to protect yourself from investment fraud:

1. Check registration

Check the registration of any individual or business trying to sell you an investment or give you advice. Visit **CheckBeforeYouInvest.ca**.

2. Check their category

Not all types of registration are the same – firms and individuals can be registered to provide a range of products and services.

3. Check disciplinary history

Find out if an individual or firm has ever broken regulatory rules in the past.

Contact the Ontario Securities Commission to:

- 1. Check registration
- 2. Report a person or firm is not registered
- **3.** Inform if an individual or firm is offering you something that is not permitted by their registration category
